1. Clarify Business Goals

2. Use Role Context

3. Ask for Data-Driven Insights

E.g., "Highlight top 3 revenue drivers from the dataset."

4. Structure Outputs

E.g., "Provide output as a Markdown table with columns: Metric, Value."

5. Specify KPIs

E.g., "Analyze NPS trend by quarter, include growth rate."

6. Provide Examples

7. Segment Data Requests

22. Control Tone
